Sermon Applications

On a scale of 1 to 10, how truthful do you believe you are?

If you stood before God and His eyes looked deep in your soul, how honest would *He* find you?

Pay attention this week to how honest you are to other and to yourself.

Use the concordance in the back of your Bible or an internet resource (e.g. [www.blueletterbible.com](http://www.blueletterbible.com)) to find the word truth. What observations do you find in the Bible about truth?

Consider how you tell the truth. Do you tell it in love? Are you kind enough to tell the truth? Are you kind in the way you tell the truth? You can generally tell if you are kind by the way others react.

How do you react when other tell you the truth, whether they speak it kindly or not? Are you gracious enough to discern and consider what they say rather than immediately justify yourself, or become angry and hurt?

The most important truth is God's truth, to whom will you share God's truth in the Gospel?
